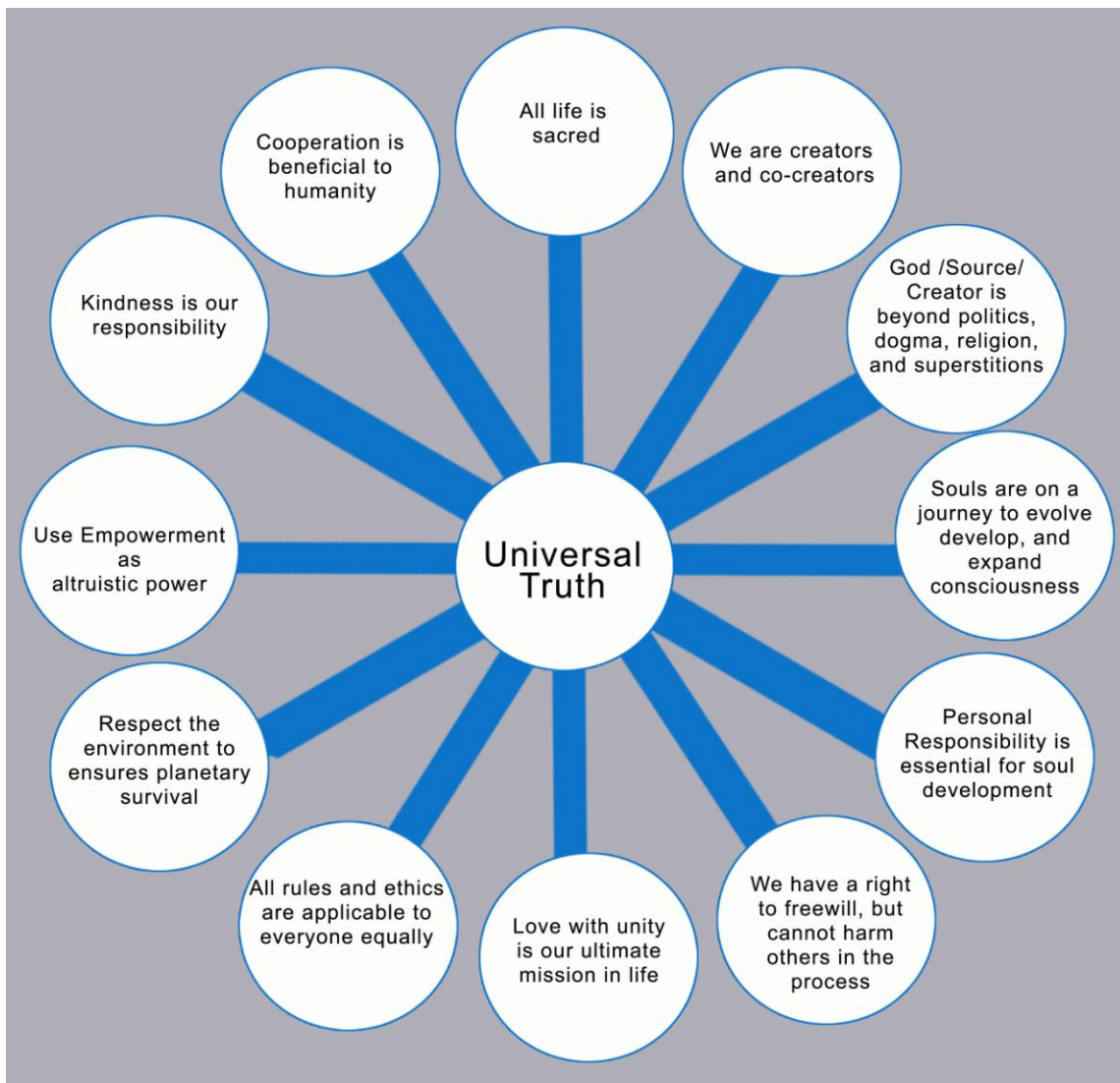

The shift from a negative suppressive leadership model to community minded councils are the only option for the world to be balanced back to a positive path. Each person has a soul that matters and negative predatory behaviors must be abandoned. Loyalty to the human race is imperative and required for any leadership representing humanity. Critical thinking and independent thought must be fostered in our communities and judging others and controlling them is a path we must abandon and never condone.

Consciousness

What is consciousness? It is an awareness of life, thoughts, sense of self, and the elements of life. It is an awareness of others. It is an awareness of the sacredness of life. It is acknowledging life through thoughts, feelings, emotions, actions and reactions. Living in a state of consciousness means that there is a balance or symbiosis to how one fits into existence within the environment. It is necessary to understand how we exist in the physical world as an expression of a much bigger existence. Our physical expression of ourselves is only part of who we are. Having power over others and ensuring that they follow an agenda, set of controls, or are suppressed is the misuse of power. Empowerment works to progress everyone to the same level of power.

11. Kindness is our responsibility.

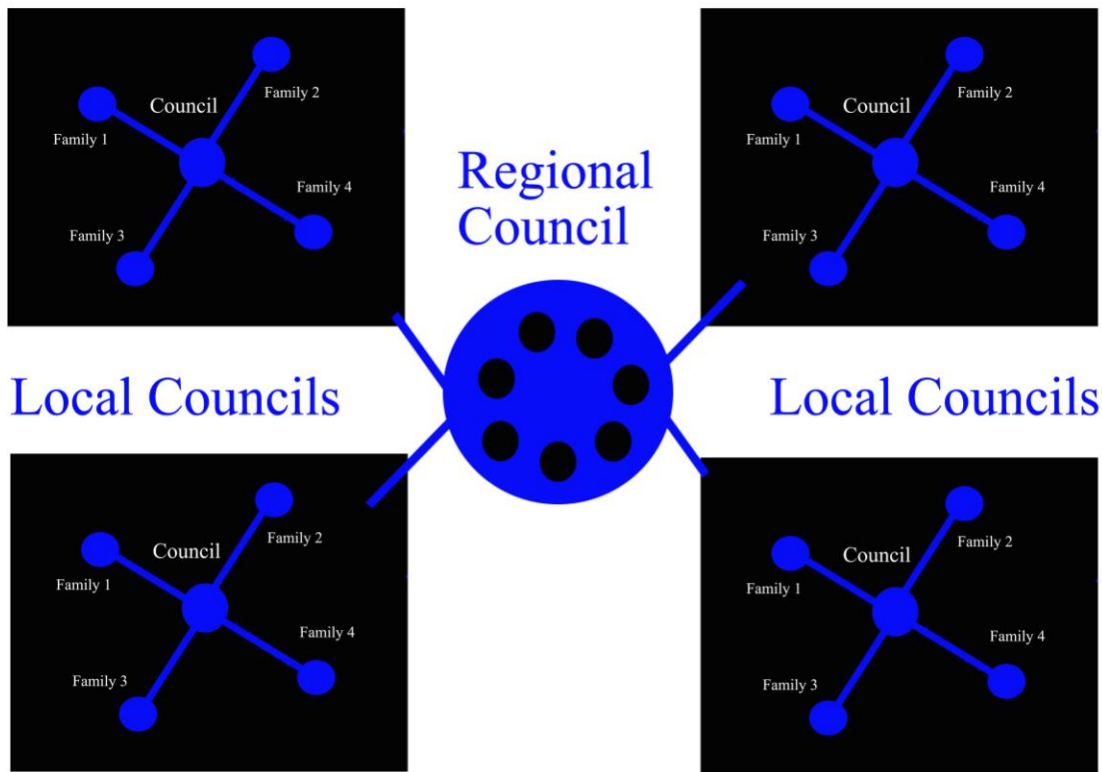

It is time to mature beyond negative discourse and immature banter and understand that only those that you take responsibility for are those you have an interest in judgmental conversation in order to ensure responsibility. 12. Cooperation is beneficial to humanity.

Community Councils

Each neighborhood or joint land community can form councils where everyone is welcome to participate and add input. No one is the leader and all can have a contribution. There are opportunities for those with experience to offer advice and support. Each council can start by meeting weekly or monthly based on establishment needs. Then, duration can be established based on need. The size of the council can be based on the density of the area and the ability of the people to organize. The council can be as small as a few neighbors or as large as a neighborhood. Once established, each council can send delegates to form regional councils when a need arises to address issues. No one is elected and anyone can go and participate. This is an important principle to ensure integrity and freedom for all. The more self-sufficient the better a community can create freedom and sovereignty.



Understanding the Structure

It is important to remain a group of common people with common interests. Everyone has the same amount of power and empowerment. Even children are welcome to come and be heard. Also, no business or institution should use these councils to benefit in monetary gain or notoriety. These councils should be seen as private and sovereign of politics, dogma, or business. This foundation will ensure the purity of the intent of being a community council.

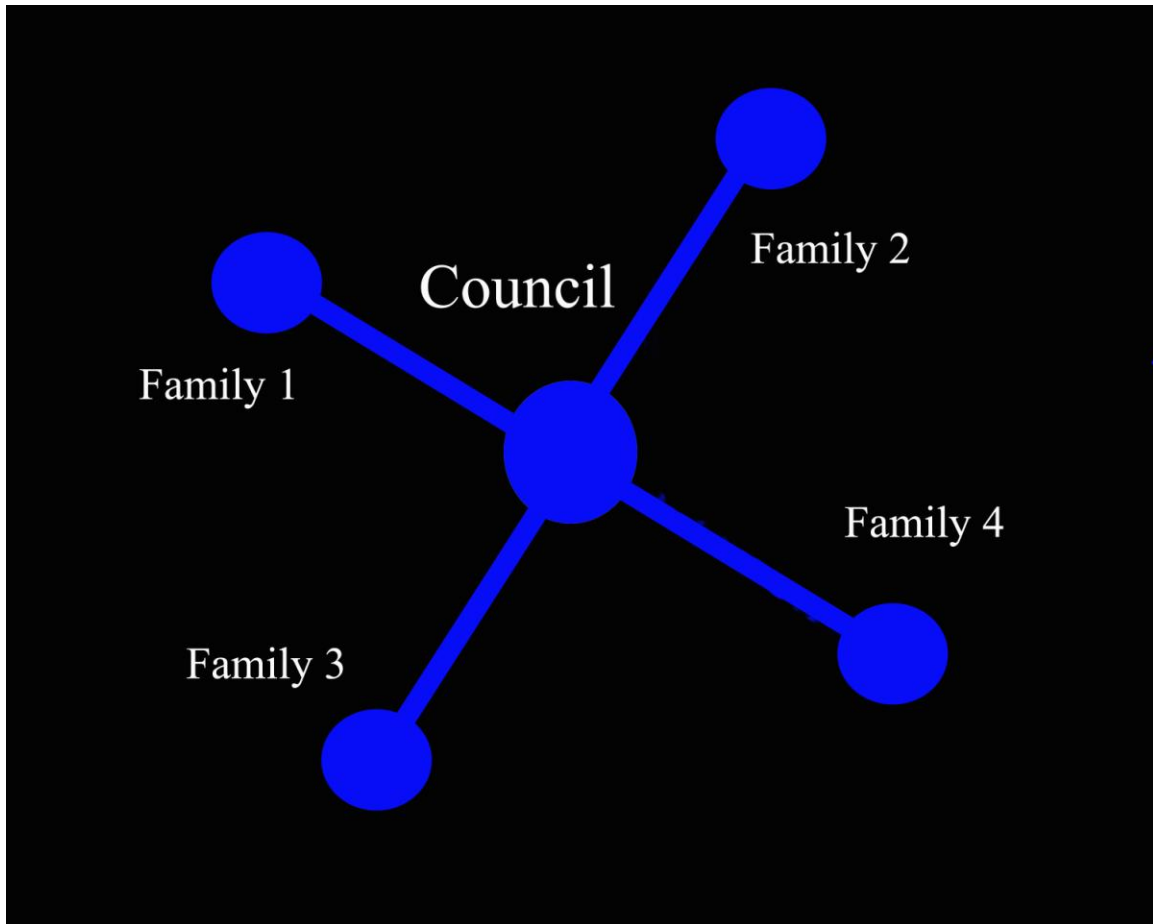

The idea is for us to become a community based sovereign society. Sovereign is essential as we are seeing the crumbling of a hierarchy based political system across our world. We need to see the bigger picture of what humanity can be. It is about the whole body of humanity in a holistic perspective and not just favoring the ones at the top. There is no top and this is why the diagrams are round. Everyone has the same value. Councils are formed in each area. These councils can be a few neighbors, a neighborhood or an entire area. No one is elected and anyone can join and attend the meetings. A time is set for meetings. Councils can meet once a month or as needed. When setting them up and establishing them, councils will likely need to meet more often. Councils meet to address needs of the area the council represents. Each person should move towards self sufficiency as much as possible. Even if you have a small yard, you can produce enough for your family to trade with others who will specialize in something else. For example, one neighbor might have apple trees and peach trees. Another neighbor might grow tomatoes and potatoes. Now if you have 10 to 20 neighbors in a council it becomes clear how this will encourage independence. You can further trade with other councils.

Homestead Focused

When the people take back their responsibility for their basic needs, they also gain back their sovereignty. If each community has food, shelter and basic needs met, then they can ensure that corporations do not take over society ever again. They can also ensure that their food and water stays pure and unaltered with harmful substances. Creating as much independence as possible will also move humanity towards energy independence thus more freedom from corporate interests. The homestead philosophy fosters this independence. It does not have to cost a fortune to become a homestead. Research the best supplies to get and practices that will work for better self sufficiency. The current paradigm will not take care of many of the things we have counted on in the past. Now is the time to take personal responsibility. Think about how control is taken in society. We rely on electric, water, food and resources. We have become complacent and as many of us have realized, this can no longer be the case if we are to remain free citizens of the earth. Now is the time to form these councils and care for each other.

Here you can see how the councils can be set up. Each council can also be called upon when help is needed. Councils trade with others and solve problems when more input is needed. In order to make this work, councils must take on a generous attitude of abundance. If we are self sufficient and community minded, we free ourselves from political influence and control. We also free ourselves to have more time with family and friends. It is even suggested that having a meal once a month or so with your local council as it is bonding and a great time to bring your supplies to be shared with others. The regional council is activated when the need arises. Otherwise, you solve local issues with your local councils.

TYPES OF COMMUNITIES

Community councils can be made from existing neighborhoods or from joint land communities. Each community can participate in the council and contribute to community projects and needs. Existing neighborhoods allow autonomy for current residence and require less change than joint land communities. Joint land communities can also be tailored for different cultures. For example, some can cater to young families or some can cater to those who live very active lives or are centered on certain interests or practices.

Creating homestead communities is not about a commune, parties or taking advantage of others. It is about community and respecting each other as neighbors who are friends. You would show respect to your current neighbor and would not impose upon them in many things. Instead, by supporting each other we take back our sovereignty and become self sufficient. If you have food, shelter, water and a community of people to support you, then the dark forces of this world are less of a focus and they have less power over us. We are choosing to have and be a solution. This also allows people to search and find the community that is right for them. There are the universal standards and unique community standards that work as well for joint land communities. Those who use their already set neighborhoods to form a council would not have those unique standards and would choose to just have the universal standards. You can scale the community homestead councils to fit every type of community so that everyone can make it work. An apartment building for example can even have a version of this. They will have more limitations, but can still do it. Everyone is free to have their own religion or spiritual beliefs. We focus on the things we have in common. We all need to eat, teach our children and young adults, we all need to help each other with skills and projects.

EXISTING NEIGHBORHOODS

Existing neighborhoods can be those in a particular development, road, or neighborhood. They can also be an apartment complex or a condominium neighborhood. The idea is that each person has their own residence and works towards creating and self sufficiency according to their ability. For example, indoor growing can take place in an apartment building and shared with neighbors who can concentrate on growing different things. Water can be collected from pans or containers on patios or shared areas. In this instance, permission would need to be gained from the apartment owner to create community gardens. In neighborhoods where people have their own yards, fruit and nut trees as well as edible bushes and other sources of food can be implemented. Neighbors can concentrate on certain items to trade with others. These concepts are scalable and can be implemented with some creativity. Neighbors come together for projects and support each other with their skills.

JOINT LAND COMMUNITIES

These types of communities are growing across the earth. This is where someone purchases land and designates this land to be developed for a community purpose. There could be 20 acres with a community garden, orchards and livestock. People develop homes on the property and share some resources like a community garden, barn, or water supply. Each person has their privacy and personal space, but they share a community area and some resources. This makes self sufficiency easier and less time consuming. Also, the members of the community will come together to work on projects and development. This shares the burden of caring for the land and the resources. This also provides a support system for educating children and other purposes.

Empowerment and Sovereignty

Remember that there are no bosses or leaders, just people with expertise that are used as consultants on certain matters. For example in one local council, you may have someone trained in education. They can become the home schooling teacher or consultant to families within the local council. It is extremely important to have a council mission and transitional charter. You can add to this document as your community council needs. However, everyone should commit to the universal truths codes of ethics. These are basic standards of living that we should all live by to respect life on planet earth and the freedom each soul should have as sovereign beings. Remember to treat each other as neighbors and do not try to control others, discriminate based on ideas whether they be of a particular religion or political influence. Each person has the right to their land, resources, and ideas regardless of how much one does or does not agree. As long as they are not harming others, do not impose upon them. The idea is to move beyond a control society and to a sovereign and mature community.

MINDSET

We must begin with our mindset. The Universal Truths help us accomplish this. Without a mature spiritual state, we will only end up with a predator prey mentality once again. We must come to a place where money is not our focus anymore. There will be a time of transition for most where we will use it to establish a more independent existence. However, if we are ever to be free from the debt mentality then we need to get to a place where we get beyond the idea of money. This will take time. However, if you see someone who has a need and you can help then do so. Many are creating homesteads and even going off grid. They are simplifying their lives. They are producing their food and going back to the earth as many would describe it. You see, the current political system is something that needs to change. It is difficult for some to see that both sides of politics have divided people on a deep level. If we remove the politics and really focus on what is best for the people, then we can see a very different human society.

When we become people oriented, the people govern themselves by being independent and respecting others. We need to see others as ourselves. This means that when a neighbor needs help building their house, we show up and help without expecting money. It means that when they are hungry, you share food. It means that when the community has a problem, that we come together to solve that problem and work together on a solution without seeking control or power over others. It means that our egos need to be in check and that we see others as an extension of ourselves. Ask yourself if you are ready to do this. If you are not, then ask why. Do inner work and introspection. The alternative to this is a control system of dominance and slavery.

SOLUTION BASED

We can see much effort towards this currently. If we are to move away from this, then we must **actively create the alternative**. We must BE the solution. Some are focused on the problems. This will only hinder human progress. We need to be solution based. We choose a people focused homestead community model. This means that we do not have to rely on businesses, politics, and institutions to provide for us. We become personally responsible and independent incrementally until we can transform society on a large scale. We stop looking to leaders and lead ourselves. We stop expecting others to do for us and take the initiative to do for all of us. This mindset is essential to starting this process. If you do not resonate with this, then it will not work. You need to be at the point where you genuinely want peace for you, your family and those around you. You need to respect their autonomy and sovereignty.

Many crimes would be a thing of the past if we freely shared with each other. It would free us to concentrate on more important things. We would work less and play more. We would be free from control and obligations of a system that is not about the people, but rather about control and gaining power for a select few. Instead, we recognize that we are all the same and we all should have access to the same. It will vary based on need, but everyone can access what they need.

This means we have to stop looking for others to take care of us and be our leaders... we lead ourselves by self governing. When you are at this point of awareness, then you are ready for the next step. We must be people of maturity and understanding that we are one. When someone suffers it will come back to us as well. When someone prospers then it can come back to us as well. We need to get beyond this duality idea and the competition. We must see how **cooperation is the answer**. Do inner work and forgive and let go of the past. Decide that peace and true freedom with respect is what you desire. Get in the right mindset to be part of each other because we are each other....

- *Generous attitude*
- *A desire to respect others*
- *No one controls others*
- *Those with specialties become consultants for the community*
- *Children are welcome to help us solve problems*

Follow the Universal Truths. This is crucial as it is the condition of the soul that makes all the difference and allows us to speak with one voice.

Education System

In communities, families can take back control of the education system. Philosophy on Education Finances

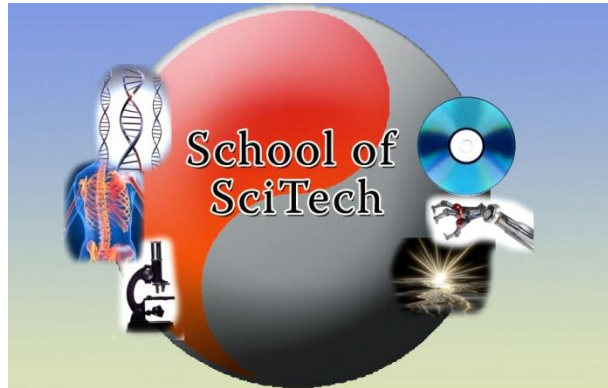

- Real life education will be emphasized.

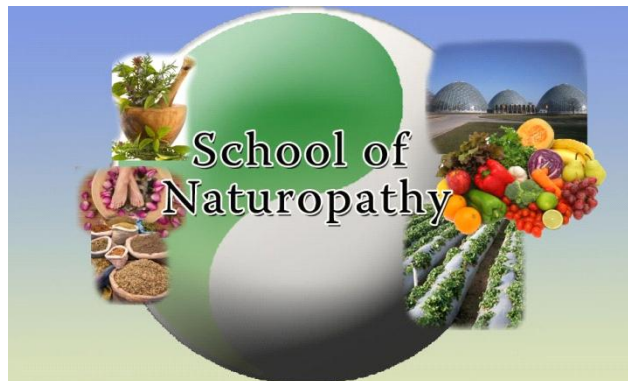

Notice that each quadrant has 2 colors representing the school with one earth metal and one earth color. This quadrant has silver and red for the School of SciTech.

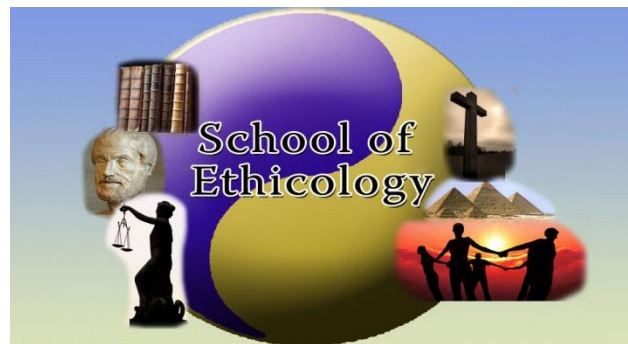

 - i. **Licensed Rights** means the rights granted to You subject to the terms and conditions of this Public License, which are limited to all Copyright and Similar Rights that apply to Your use of the Licensed Material and that the Licensor has authority to license.
